

PROCLAMATION  
PRIMARY ELECTION  
CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING

In compliance with W.S. 22-2-109, Wyoming Statutes, the County Clerk of Campbell County, Wyoming, hereby gives notice of the Primary Election to be held on August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014, in all Districts and Precincts in Campbell County, Wyoming:

**Date and Time of Primary Election:** August 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014, 7:00 AM until 7:00 PM

**Date of Final Registration:** August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2014 is the last day to register to vote with the County Clerk before Primary Election Day. (Voter registration is also permitted at the polls on Primary Election Day.)

To register to vote, you must be at least 18 years of age by the day of the Election, a U.S. citizen, and bona fide resident of Campbell County, Wyoming. No person may be registered to vote, who has been adjudicated mentally incompetent, or has been convicted of a felony and his/her civil rights have not been restored. When registering to vote you will need to bring acceptable identification.

**Filing Offices and Dates:** May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2014 thru May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2014 are the filing dates for all National, State, County and Municipal Offices for the Primary Election. You will need to file with the Secretary of State for National and State Offices; with the County Clerk for the County Offices, Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen Offices, and with the City and Town Clerks for the Municipal Offices.

### **CAMPAIGN REPORTING REQUIREMENTS:**

Every candidate, candidate's campaign committee or political action committee, whether successful or not, shall file a fully itemized statement of campaign receipts, at least seven (7) days before any Primary, General or Special Election with information required current to any day from the 8<sup>th</sup> day up to the 14<sup>th</sup> day before the election, (5<sup>th</sup> thru 11<sup>th</sup> of August, 2014). Every candidate, candidate's campaign committee or political action committee, whether successful or not, shall file a fully itemized statement of receipts and expenditures within ten (10) days after any Primary, General or Special Election. (August 29<sup>th</sup> 2014). Those candidates that file with the Secretary of State's Office will file their reports with the Secretary of State's Office and those that file with the County Clerk or the City/Town Clerk shall file their statements with the County Clerk's Office.

A candidate, who fails to file a full statement of receipts required by the 7<sup>th</sup> day (August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2014) before the election, shall have his/her name printed on a list as specified under WS 22-25-108. The list shall be posted and made available to the public.

A candidate who fails to file a full and complete statement of receipts and expenditures by the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the election, (August 29<sup>th</sup>, 2014) is subject to a civil penalty and cost as provided by WS 22-25-108. Failure to file within one month of the report due date will make the candidate ineligible to run as a candidate for any state or local office for five (5) years or until the required statement is filed.

A violation of the campaign reporting provisions of the Wyoming Election Code may constitute a misdemeanor and be punishable by a fine as provided by WS 22-26-112.

Precinct Committeepeople shall not be required to file a statement of receipts or a statement of receipts and expenditures.

### **ABSENTEE VOTING**

Applications for Absentee Ballots may be requested from the County Clerk's Election Department through Monday, August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Qualified electors may have their ballot mailed to them, or they may vote their ballot at the County Clerk's Election Department, 40 days prior to the election (Thursday, July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014) and through Monday August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

### **SAMPLE BALLOTS**

A Sample Ballot and List of all Polling Places will be published in the News Record one time between the dates of August 5<sup>th</sup>, and August 18<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Sample Ballots will be in the office of the Campbell County Clerk, starting July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2014 for inspection by any interested person(s).
