

League of Women Voters forums address the Quarter Penny Tax issue

The League of Women voters plans a public informational forum concerning the Quarter Penny Sales Tax. The Gillette forum will be held Monday, September 25 from 6:30 to 8 PM in the Gillette City Council Chambers of City Hall in Gillette, at 201 E. 5th Street. A similar forum will be held at Wright Town Hall, 395 Lariat Way, Wright, on Monday October 9 from 6:30 to 8 PM. The Forums are free and the public is invited to participate and take an active part in their government.

Participants who want to speak to either side of the quarter penny sales tax issue are urged to prepare a statement of two minutes or less to be presented at the opening of the forum. The order of the speakers will be determined by a sign in process. Questions and comments from the public will be addressed by a guest panel.

Gillette Public Access TV will broadcast the Gillette forum live and will archive. The recorded forums will be available on the GPA-TV webpage www.gillettewy.gov, just click on the Spotlight link on the right side of the webpage. The League of Women Voters presents educational forums to enable individuals to make informed decisions about their government.

Voting on the quarter penny issue is November 7th. You must be a resident of Campbell County to vote in this special election. All residents who voted in the 2016 General Election are already registered to vote in this election.
