

A workshop was conducted on January 19, 2015 at 4:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the workshop: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Nelson Litaba, Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilman Danny Preston and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera. Also present was EDC Brandi Harlow and members from the High Plains Sentinel.

Workshop Discussion: The Wright Town Council met with representatives of the Hay Creek Golf Course Advisory Board regarding the Golf Professional open position. Derek Barnhurst, Penny Bear, Nick McGraw, and Cameron Brown were present for the discussion. Discussion took place on whether or not to hire a Golf Professional to replace Cameron and the assets that a Professional could bring to a course to benefit the course and community. The Council will continue to keep communication open with the board throughout this process. Cameron stated that he would be closing the kitchen at the end of the month.

The Council discussed the High Plains Sentinel newspaper eligibility status of being a legal publication source for the Town of Wright. Information from the High Plains Sentinel was provided and reviewed by the Council, which would suffice as proof that they meet the threshold of a paid circulation of 500 which is required by Wyoming State Statute. Information will be sent to the town attorney for review.

Council reviewed the lease agreement with Wright Community Assistance regarding the Community Closet. Discussion took place on the terms of the agreement as well as the lease amount of the agreement.

Mike Cole, representing HDR Engineering spoke to the Council about engineering services for the Town of Wright. Mike will propose a draft agreement for the Council to review and act on at the next meeting.

Council reviewed the current budget for fiscal year 2014/2015. Although most of the insurance claims have been completed, there is still work that has not been finished. Mayor Kingan will discuss with Lyle Murdock on the status of the claims and report back to the Council. The Council budget retreat will be schedule in the coming months. Financial statements/budget sheets will continue to be provided to the council on a regular basis.
