The Town Council thanked him for his service with the Town of Wright and wished him well. No Campbell County Sheriff's Report was presented. No Public Works report was given. No Building Official Report was presented. Brandi Harlow presented the Economic Development Coordinator Report; Brandi presented to the council some of the items in the Comprehensive plan and would like to have the council work on a chapter at a time to fulfill some of the goals in the plan. Max Davis presented the SCCAC Report. Red Hills Veterinary would like to have a wall locker located at the Ag Complex and be able to have their clinics there instead of the Multi-Purpose building. Council agreed that would be ok but there would need to be a lease law in effect for dogs. Eric Barlow Campbell County House of Representatives presented an update on the Budget hearings for and development of the 2017-2018 Biennial Budget. The Committee is also scheduled to review legislation related to school capital construction and other legislation on interim topics, as necessary.
