

A workshop was conducted on July 8, 2013 at 7:00 p.m at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the workshop: Councilman Nelson Litaba, Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Danny Preston, Mayor Albin and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera.

Deputy Hanson presented the Campbell County Sheriff’s Office Report. Rick Hale presented the Public Works Report. Lyle Murdock presented the Building Official Report. Larry Yeradi spoke about the charity golf tournament that is scheduled for August 3, 2013, stating that this is the 6th year holding the fundraiser. He requested that the green fees be waived for the event, which will be discussed in the regular meeting. Owen Lindblom from HDR Engineering spoke about the New Town Hall project, stating that he is working on the entrance to the facility. Paul Ludwig from Linc Energy gave an update to the Council on the Underground Coal Gasification (UCG) project. He will continue to keep the Council updated on the progress of the site and also be notifying the public in the near future.
