

A workshop was conducted on September 23, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the workshop: Councilman Nelson Litaba, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Glenn Holt, Mayor Tim Albin and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera. Absent was Councilman Danny Preston.

Deputy Hanson provided the Campbell County Sheriff's Department report. Rick Hale presented the Public Works Report. Brandi Beecher presented the Economic Development Coordinator Report. Mayor Albin presented Jeff Rech with a plaque to signify the Mayor and Council's appreciation and dedication to serving the people of Campbell County and the Campbell County Fire Department. Pat Neely distributed a letter to the Council regarding the Super Citizens Party that he is requesting the Council sponsor in the amount of \$225.00. It was noted that action would be taken in the regular meeting on the item of business. **NO ACTION WAS TAKEN IN THIS WORKSHOP**

Mayor Albin led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mayor Albin called the regular Town Council meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. with the following being present: Councilman Holt, Councilwoman Gilbertson, Councilman Litaba and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera. Absent was Councilman Preston.

The workshop continued with the Bill Shank with the Campbell County Fire Department. Mr. Shank thanked the Council for approving the budget amendment to account for the increased amount for pension benefits. Mr. Shank also stated that he would be able to sit on the CAREBOARD as a representative of the Town of Wright.
