

A Town Council Special Meeting was conducted on April 21, 2014 at 6:07 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the meeting: Councilman Glenn Holt (6:56 p.m.), Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Nelson Litaba and Mayor Albin. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera, Building Official Lyle Murdock, and Economic Development Coordinator Brandi Harlow.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Councilwoman Gilbertson moved to approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> read of Town of Wright Ordinance No. 2014-02, an ordinance of the Town of Wright, Wyoming, approving the re-subdivision of lots 3A, 3B, 4A, 4B, 5A, and 5B, Block 1 Wright Estates, to lots 3C, 4C, 4D, and 5C, Block 1 Wright Estates. Councilman Litaba seconded the motion, motion carried.

**DISCUSSION:** The Wright Town Council discussed options and locations for implementing "NO PARKING" signs on Reata and Ranch Court. Councilman Danny Preston, Councilman Glenn Holt, Public Works Operations Manager Rick Hale, and Building Official Lyle Murdock will coordinate a time to meet with the surrounding business owners to talk about options for parking semi-tractor trailer trucks and report their findings to the Wright Town Council. The Wright Town Council will discuss the job description for the SCCAC Operations Manager at the Budget Retreat. Discussion took place on the health requirements for boarding animals at the new SCCAC facility. Staff will research how other towns and counties handle the health requirements. As soon as the new boarding pens are available, the new pen owners will be notified. A certified letter will also be sent to the Riding and Roping Club specifying the date in which the current corral area will need to be vacated. The council discussed scheduling for the town facilities, including the new SCCAC facility. It will be discussed in further detail at the Budget Retreat. Council agreed the Community Clean Up/Bulk Garbage Days will be in June and September. Furnishings for the New Town Hall facility will need to be discussed in greater detail at the Budget Retreat. It was discussed to have Linc Energy and/or DEQ come to the Town of Wright to hold an informational public hearing to inform the public and answer any questions having to do with the underground coal gasification.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS:** There will be Executive Session on Personnel following the Special Meeting. The Budget Retreat will be April 25-27 at the Ranch at Ucross. The next Town Council meeting will be April 28, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. with a workshop at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall.

**ADJOURNMENT:** The Special Meeting was adjourned at 7:30 p.m. with a short break before moving into Executive Session on Personnel.
