

A Town Council Workshop was conducted on May 19, 2014 at 6:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the workshop: Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilman Danny Preston, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Nelson Litaba and Mayor Albin. Also present were Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera, Public Works Operations Manager Rick Hale, and Building Official Lyle Murdock, Economic Development Coordinator Brandi Harlow, and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig.

The Wright Town Council met with representatives of Nomadic Land Services, Devon Energy Corporation, and Dawson Geophysical Company regarding the fracking of a well located south of town. The request is to put micro seismic equipment on town property to obtain data underground for fracking purposes. The Town Council will have Town Attorney, Rick Erb review the permit document and the item of business will be voted on at the next meeting. The Town Council also met with representatives from Wyoming Department of Transportation to discuss traffic concerns in and around Wright. Discussion took place on speed limit signs, turning lanes and a traffic light at the Hwy 59 & Hwy 387 intersection. Mark Gillett, WYDOT Research Advisory Committee District Engineer and Jim Evensen, District Traffic Engineer stated that WYDOT would need to perform a traffic impact study and/or a warrant study on the area before anything would be implemented. Council also reviewed the proposed budget for fiscal year 2014/2015. Another meeting was set up for May 27, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. to finish reviewing the budget.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: The next Town Council meeting will be May 27, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. with a workshop at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall. There will be a works session with the Planning and Zoning Commission at 5:30 p.m. prior to the workshop. Council will also meet at 5:00 p.m. to finish reviewing the proposed budget for fiscal year 2014/2015.
