

A workshop was conducted on July 28, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the workshop: Mayor Tim Albin, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Danny Preston, Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilman Nelson Litaba and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera.

Deputy Preston presented the Campbell County Sheriff's Office Report. Rick Hale presented the Public Works Report. Lyle Murdock presented the Building Official Report. Mayor Albin read the Economic Development Coordinator Report. Cameron Brown presented the Hay Creek Golf Course Report.

NO ACTION WAS TAKEN IN THIS WORKSHOP.

Mayor Albin led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular Town Council meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. with the following being present: Mayor Albin, Councilwoman Gilbertson, Councilman Holt, Councilman Preston, Councilman Litaba, and Clerk/Treasurer Chrissy Herrera. The workshop continued with Mary Silvernell, Campbell County Commissioner Candidate, introducing herself and providing her thoughts on the airport for the county.

CONSENT AGENDA: Councilman Preston moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Councilwoman Gilbertson seconded the motion, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS: Council discussed the Wyoming Community Gas-Community Project Designation in the amount of \$1,665.52. Council considered using the funds for a new sign for the SCCAC and the Wright Community Center. Council would like to obtain the values of the signs before making a decision.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: The Candidate Forums will be held on July 29th and 30th from 6:00 p.m.-9:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall. The next Town Council meeting will be August 11, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. with a workshop at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall.
