

A Public Hearing was conducted on May 18, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilman Danny Preston, Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Nelson Litaba, and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig.

Public Hearing: The purpose of the Public Hearing was to hear comments on the Retail Liquor License transfer from Kury Reynolds, to KR Golf, LLC, dba Hay Creek Golf Course. With no comments from the public, the hearing closed at 6:05 pm. At 6:06 pm the special meeting was called to order by Mayor Kingan. New Business: Councilman Preston moved to approve the Retail Liquor License transfer from Kury Reynolds, to KR Golf, LLC dba Hay Creek Golf Course. Councilwoman Gilbertson seconded the motion, motion carried.

Councilwoman Gilbertson moved to approve the appointment of Councilman Litaba as the Official Voting Delegate for the 2015 WAM Convention. Councilman Preston seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Rick Caldwell with High Dessert Development gave a presentation on the High Dessert Development project. The project will be completed in phases and will include a truck stop, C Store, hotel, retail stores, and a housing development, which will consist of condos and single residential housing. The single residential housing will be under a Home Owners Association. The Planning and Zoning Commission will provide input and recommendations to the Wright Town Council accordingly. There will also be a public hearing to gather input from the community. The project will enhance the Economic Development for the Town of Wright by providing housing, commercial and retail facilities. The first phase of the project will include the construction of retail buildings. Zoning changes will not be required for this phase. The project is scheduled to be completed within five years of the start date. The start date is to be determined at a later date.
