

A regular meeting was conducted on May 26, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilman Danny Preston, Councilman Glenn Holt, Councilwoman Lori Gilbertson, Councilman Nelson Litaba, and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig.

Gene Hanson presented the Campbell County Sheriff's Report. Rick Hale presented the Public Works Report, Lyle Murdock presented the Building Official Report, Brandi Harlow presented the Economic Development Report, Brandi informed the Town Council that the Town of Wright has received a Rec Mill Grant for the Community Center remodel in the amount of \$300,000, she is also working on getting a Boys and Girls Club established in the Town of Wright. Max Davis presented the Ag Complex update.

Mayor Kingan led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular Town Council meeting to order.

Consent Agenda: Councilman Holt moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Councilwoman Gilbertson seconded the motion, motion carried. Mickey Roby Van-Hemert approached the Town Council about the process of using the Movie Equipment to have Movies in the Park, she was advised that the Town owns the equipment so she would just need to reserve the equipment and Building Official Lyle Murdock would assist her in getting it set up, along with the Town Maintenance Dept.
