PUBLIC HEARING (7:00 p.m.) A Public Hearing was held to hear public input on Ordinance 2019-01 an Ordinance of the Town of Wright approving the re-zone of Properties owned by Robert & Shirleen Ferguson & Winco Disposal, LLC. There were no public comments and public hearing was closed at 7:02 pm. Zone change from zoning district R-3 (Multi-Unit Residential) to L-1 Light Industrial located adjacent to the south side of Highway 387 across from the Hay Creek Commercial Park located in a portion of the SE1/4SW1/4 & NW1/4 Section 33, T44N, R72W. Town of Wright, Campbell County, Wyoming. Councilman Robb seconded the motion. Motion carried. Councilman Schrader made a motion to table the request to waive the fees at the SCCAC for the Motivational Rodeo School for youth until Tom Reeves can present to the Council further information and a budget for the Motivation Rodeo School, Councilman Phipps seconded the motion. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve the bid from Croell, Inc in the amount of \$397,754.50 for the 2019 Street Resurfacing Project which includes Glenn Court and Hay Creek Rd. with the option of adding additional streets to the project.
