

PROCLAMATION
PRIMARY ELECTION 2020
CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING

In compliance with Wyoming Statue 22-2-109, the County Clerk of Campbell County, Wyoming, hereby gives notice of the Primary Election to be held on August 18, 2020, in all Districts and Precincts in Campbell County, Wyoming.

Date and Time of Primary Election: August 18, 2020, 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Date of Final Registration: August 3, 2020 is the last day to register to vote with the County Clerk before the Primary Election. If voting absentee, in person, after August 3, you may register and vote in the Elections Office. You may also register and vote at your designated polling place on Election Day.

To register to vote, you must be at least 18 years of age by the day of the election, a U.S. citizen and bona fide resident of Campbell County, Wyoming. No person may be registered to vote who has been adjudicated mentally incompetent or who has been convicted of a felony and his/her civil rights have not been restored. When registering to vote you will need to bring acceptable identification.

Filing Offices and Dates: The Primary Election filing period for all Federal, State, County and Municipal Offices is May 14 through May 29, 2020. You will need to file with the Secretary of State for Federal and State Offices, with the County Clerk for County Offices, including Precinct Committeemen and Committeewomen and with the City and Town Clerks for Municipal Offices.

Precinct Committeepersons shall not be required to file a statement of contributions and expenditures.

Absentee Voting: Applications for absentee ballots may be requested from the County Clerk's Election Department through Monday August 17, 2020. Qualified electors may have their ballot delivered to them or they may vote their ballot at the County Clerk's Election Department 45 days prior to the election, beginning Thursday July 2, 2020, through Monday August 17, 2020. A qualified elector may apply for an absentee ballot anytime by applying in person, in writing or by telephone. If the ballot is not able to be obtained in person by the elector, they must provide the address to which the ballot is to be mailed or the name of the individual the elector designates, in writing, to deliver the ballot to the elector. Ballots must be returned to the Election Department by August 18, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. to be counted Primary Election Day. Absentee ballots are not available on election day.

Sample Ballots: A sample ballot and list of all polling places will be published in the Gillette News Record one time between August 4 and August 17, 2020. Sample ballots will be in the office of the Campbell County Clerk beginning July 2, 2020, for inspection by any interested person(s).
