

A Special Budget Meeting was conducted on March 8, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. at the Wright Town Hall in Wright, Wyoming. The following were present for the meeting: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilman Doug Schrader, Councilman Mike Phipps, Councilman Justin Robb, Councilman Joel Morgan, Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig, and Deputy Clerk Paula Strohschein. Dawn Turner, Wayne Vaughn and Janeen Bissy from the Wright Days Committee attended the budget meeting to discuss funding for the Wright Days Events to be held June 25 through June 27, 2021 they were unable to do any fund raising for the 2021 Wright Days Events due to Covid, it was decided that they would not be able to get the Mud Bog Races this year as they do not have enough funds, they would also not have enough funding to hire the Ambulance Crew to be on standby for the event which would be a requirement, the board advised that they were in need of volunteers to help out with the fishing derby. Wayne Vaughn Director of Wright Community Assistance presented the Wright Community Assistance funding request for the FY21/22 budget. Building Officials Jed Holder and Sam Proffer from Campbell County Public Works were present to provide an update to the Wright inspection services performed for 2020-2021, the Town of Wright will be turning over the GIS maintenance to the Campbell County Public Works Department. Budget Items presented for review for the FY2021/2022 were the Mayor/Council Budget, the Municipal Court Budget, the Clerk/Treasurer Budget, Medical Services Budget, Public Services Budget which includes the CCMH contract, Fire Department contract and the Sheriff's Dept contract.
