A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE WYOMING ENERGY AUTHORITY ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF WRIGHT FOR THE USE OF FEDERAL ENERGY PROGRAM (GRANT) FUNDS

FOR ENERGY CONSERVATION MEASURES

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Wright desires to participate in the Wyoming Energy Authority Grant Program to assist in financing this project; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Wright recognizes the need for the project; and,

WHEREAS, the Energy Grant will provide energy conservation by window replacements, and lighting replacement located at 1413 West Elkhorn Drive, Wright Wy 82732, Window replacements and Door replacements at 1231 East Elkhorn Drive, Wright Wy 82732 and streetlights along Wright Boulevard, Wright Wy 82732.

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Town of Wright is requesting a grant from the Wyoming Energy Authority to develop the project in the fiscal year 2022-2023; and,

WHEREAS, the Wyoming Energy Authority Grant requires that certain criteria be met as described in the application form, and to the best of our knowledge this application meets those criteria; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF WRIGHT, that a grant application in the amount of \$25,000.00 be submitted to the Wyoming Energy Authority for consideration in funding the Town of Wright Energy Conservation Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Paula Strohschein, Deputy Clerk, Chris Roemmich Superintendent of Public Works and Ralph Kingan, Mayor, Town of Wright, are hereby designated as the authorized representatives of the Town of Wright to act on behalf of the Governing Body on all matters relating to this grant application.
