A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT FUNDS ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNING BODY FOR THE TOWN OF WRIGHT, CAMPBELL COUNTY, WYOMING. SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL FUNDING THROUGH THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY THE WYOMING DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE TOWN OF WRIGHT FOR THE PURPOSES OF THE WRIGHT PATHWAY PROJECT.

WITNESSETH

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the applicable federal law and released guidance regarding the American Rescue Plan Act funding received by the Town of Wright, Wyoming as a “Non-Entitlement Unit” in the amount of \$152,018.69 received on June 25, 2021, the funds must be expended only on items that fall into the final ruling guidance of the Internal Revenue Service.

**WHEREAS** a second round of payments in the amount of 152,018.69 is expected to be received in June 2022. for a total of funding in the amount of \$304,037.38.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Wright has several eligible expenditures that conform with the released guidance in the final ruling of the Internal Revenue Service

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY** for the Town of Wright that the funds received from the American Rescue Plan Act will only be expended on properly approved items brought before the governing body of the Town of Wright prior to expenditure and that all reporting requirements shall be met in accordance with federal law and released guidance regarding the ARPA funds.
