THE POSITION

The Campbell County Sheriff's Office seeks a Deputy Sheriff for Wright, Wyoming with a leadership mentality and a passion for public service. The ideal candidate will have a demonstrated ability to provide the highest quality service in enforcing Wyoming criminal laws and strives to maintain the highest standard of professional ethics and personal integrity. A candidate who is adaptable and is dedicated to achieving excellence in performance throughout the organization and in the community will thrive in this role. This role is expected to perform road patrol, investigate criminal conduct, serve civil papers, testify in court, carry and maintain firearms qualifications, among other deputy duties.

The candidate must currently have peace officer certification that is comparable to the requirements of Wyoming Peace Officer Standards and Training, must be of good moral character with no felony convictions, and not prohibited from owning or possessing a firearm. The candidate must reside in Wright, Wyoming by the date of employment. The testing process will consist of a background check, interviews, polygraph exam, medical physical test, drug screen, and psychological evaluation.

THE LOCATION

Wright has a population of 1,640 and is located in the southern portion of Campbell County, approximately 40 miles south of the county seat of Gillette.

The location offers a small town atmosphere and a family oriented community. The Town of Wright has unique amenities for its size, including a state of the art recreation center near the local library and a nine hole golf course.

Wright provides excellent education for its youth. The Wright schools have a student-teacher ratio of 11 to 1. Cottonwood Elementary School has 250 students, kindergarten through sixth grade, and approximately 200 students attend the Wright Junior/Senior High School. Wright schools are unique in that they follow a four-day school week.

Campbell County, located between the Black Hills and Big Horn Mountains, is a striking and vibrant community with a population just under 50,000 people. The County has local and regional access to the outdoors, including amazing hunting, fishing, hiking, camping, skiing, horseback riding, boating, snowmobiling, motorcycling, and ATV/UTV riding.
