Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve Resolution 2026-03 A Resolution of the Town of Wright Authorizing submission of an Unmet Housing Grant application to the State Loan and Investment Board on Behalf of the Governing Body for the Town of Wright for the purpose of Building Roads, curb and gutter, engineering and other Infrastructure for the Wyoming Housing Network Project on Hay Creek Rd in the amount of \$2,699,097.15, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve and accept the SS4A Planning and Demonstration Grant Action Plan in the amount of \$420,000.00. Reimbursement amount from grant \$336,000.00, Town of Wright match \$84,000.00 there has been an application submitted to apply for a grant to cover the match Councilman Lembke seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve the designation of the Douglas Budget as the legal publication source for the Town of Wright for the year 2026, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Schrader made a motion to approve the designation of Security State Bank to be a depository bank for public funds for the Town of Wright for the year 2026(used for general fund and money market savings). Councilman Lembke seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Lembke made a motion to approve the designation of Wyoming Government Investment Fund (WGIF) to be one of the investment groups for public funds for the Town of Wright for the year 2026. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve the designation of Wyoming Class to be one of the investment groups for public funds for the Town of Wright for the year 2026 (Used for investments). Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Schrader made a motion to approve the Resolution from Security State Bank for Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilmen Doug Schrader, Councilman Mike Phipps, Councilman Jason Lembke, and Councilman Justin Robb, Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig, and Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Paula Strohschein to sign new bank signature cards. Councilman Lembke seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Lembke made a motion to approve rescheduling the following Town Council meetings for 2026 as follows: May 25, 2026, rescheduled to May 26, 2026, for Memorial Day; October 12, 2026, rescheduled to October 13, 2026, in recognition of Columbus Day, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes.
