The Town of Wright uses its share of the 1% sales tax for the capital construction of roads, infrastructures enjoyed by all Wright residents such as our parks, ponds, Panther Park Fountain, and walking/bike paths. These monies also support local social service agencies, public safety agencies like the Fire Department, EMS Services, Emergency Management Systems and so much more. In addition, Wright's local law enforcement and animal control are funded by the 1% sales tax monies.

From 2010 to 2017 the total amount received by the Town of Wright from the 1% Sales tax was \$9,676,199.50.




HISTORICAL USE OF 1% FUNDS BY THE TOWN OF WRIGHT 2014-Present






HISTORICAL USE OF 1% FUNDS BY THE TOWN OF WRIGHT 2014-Present
