Absent: Councilman Danny Preston. **CONSENT AGENDA:** Councilman Litaba moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Items approved under the Consent Agenda include the regular meeting minutes conducted on May 8, 2017. Approval of Special Meeting Minutes conducted on May 15, 2017. Approval of Vouchers in the amount of \$50,305.00 includes payroll. Approval of the Agenda for the meeting held on May 22, 2017. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Hank Pridgeon owner of Hank's Road Side Bar and Grill requested that the Town take a look at the hours of operation and consider allowing his establishment to change his hours to reflect the surrounding areas, as Wright was the only town in close proximity that does not allow alcohol to be sold before 10:00 am on Sunday's and does not allow it to be sold after 10:00 pm. Councilman Litaba made a motion to approve the request from Hay Creek Golf Course to extend the hours of operation for the Liquor License holders in Wright for Sunday June 4, 2017 from 7:00 am to 10:00 pm for the Lori Brown Tournament to be held at the Hay Creek Golf Course. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried. Councilman Holt made a motion to approve the Catering Permit for Hay Creek Golf Club for a wedding at the Multi-Purpose building on June 10, 2017 from 1:00 pm to 2:00 am on June 11, 2017. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried. **ANNOUNCEMENTS:** The next Town Council Meeting will be held on June 12, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the Wright Town Hall. Town Hall and all Town Departments will be closed for Memorial Day May 29, 2017.
