Zone change from zoning district R-2(Multi-Unit Residential) to C-E (Enhanced Commercial District). The re-subdivision of Lot 13 to 16, Lots 21 to 30, tract B, C, D and E. Lots 13 to 16 will become Lot Y. Lots 21 to 24 will become Lot X. Lots 25 to 30 will become Lot Z. Tract C will become Lot V. Tract D will become Lot T. Tract E will become Lot U. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried. Councilman Schrader made a motion to approve Resolution 2018-01 the amendment of Ordinance 2018-01 An Ordinance of the Town of Wright, Wyoming. Providing for the Annual appropriations for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2018 ending June 30, 2019. The following accounts will be increased.

1. Campbell County Fire Department account 10-46-120 will be increased by \$6,000.00 to fund the Town of Wrights portion of the Vehicle Replacement depreciation fund. The transfer will come from unexpended funds from the Streets Repair account #10-80-779. Capital Facilities Tax (Revenue)will be increased by \$1400.00 to match the expenditure account #10-80-850. No transfer will be initiated. Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried **ANNOUNCEMENTS:** The next Town Council meeting will be held on Monday, August 27, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
